News about what we got up to in April and what we have planned for the coming month.



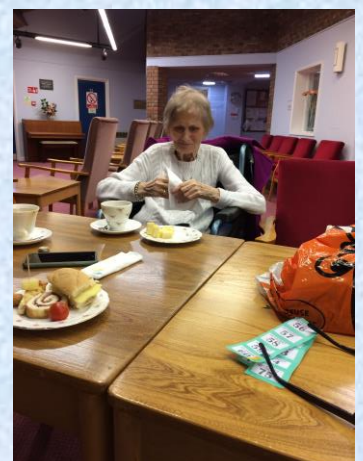
